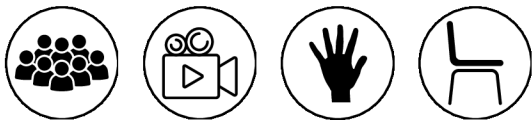
# WHERE IN THE MUSEUM

This room will be brightly lit and have a sensory projector to interact with.

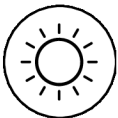


# WHAT YOU WILL SEE

The excavations are in the southwest quadrant of Magna Fort. Look for the green fences and wind sock.

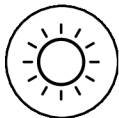


You may also see some sheep as you walk to the excavations. The path to the excavations is not accessible. You can listen and watch the video in the Activity Centre for more information about the excavations.



# WHAT YOU WILL SEE

You will see volunteers and archaeologists excavating the Roman Fort of Magna. They will be using trowels, brushes, spades, and wheelbarrows.



# WHAT YOU WILL HEAR

You will hear excavators talking, scraping back soil with their tools, and buckets of soil being emptied into wheelbarrows.



You might also hear the archaeologists talking to visitors, like yourself, at the side of the trench. You can ask them questions about what they are doing.

You cannot go into the archaeological trenches.
